### Home: Admission:

We have admitted 12 new children in the Nursery, and there is ten more waiting to join. 15 children from the nursery have joined LKG and one has joined UKG at our King's Matriculation School.

*Discharge:* We have discharged Subramoni and Manivannan and handed over them to their relatives and mother.

*Mothers:* We have appointed a new mother for one of the cottages. Still we need two more mothers for the cottages and two more mothers for the nursery.

*Other Activities:* Some of our home children have participated in the sports and games events and won in the Zonal level and participated in the District level items. Kalaiselvi

who is studying in VRV has won Gold medals in Long Jump and running and received the individual championship cup. Some children have participated in the Bible memory verse (oral and written) competitions held by the Scripture Union. Some of our home children participated in the exhibitions held in the primary section of KMS and performed well.

Our wardens and tutors are taking care of the education of the children. We are giving regular medical checkups to our children. Regular inspection of the cottages has helped to maintain the order and cleanliness of the nursery and the cottages. Children show interesting growing their own gardens.

**Request from Home:** Computer education is a must to cope up with the fast moving/growing world of computer. The need for computers is a long felt one for the home children to compete with others.

# <u>News from other Units: -</u>

*Garment Making Unit:* We are thankful to CMC & Hospital for their increased orders, which have helped the Garment Making Unit to stand firm. A few more students have joined this year and are having their training.

*Bakery:* The presence of the new kneading machine has helped to improve the quality of our bakery products. The new varieties of biscuits and puffs are well received.

**Request from the Bakery:** To increase the production and improve the quality of the products it will be good if we can use machine for cake mixing instead of manual mixing. The cost of a new Cake Mixer is Rs. 16,000.00 or USD 360. Which would help us to produce a high rate of production at lowest cost. We expect great things from God to attempt great things for God.

*Feed Mix Unit*: We producing 8 to 10 tons of Cattle feed every month for the use in our dairy. The excess of 4 to 5 tons is sold to local farmers.

We have NO funds to buy the computers and are looking for DONORS to equip the computer laboratory. **The cost of one computer would be approximately USD 650.** We will gratefully accept any help to equip our computer lab.

#### Prayer Concerns:

*More Sponsorship for Children*: Along with the admission of 14 new children, the number of un-sponsored children to increases we need more new sponsorships for our children. More sponsorship would enable us to admit new children who are waiting to join Pannai.

*Grand Parents Sponsorship:* At present there is no financial provision for the elderly residents of Pannai (the grand parents) and the housemothers who are destitute women who help in looking after the children. As mentioned in the last News Letter, we would like to start a grandparent sponsorship programme. **Sponsoring a grand parent for a year would cost US\$ 30.** We expect Sponsors or Donors for this.

*Endowment fund for Higher Education:* As children above 18 years only, mostly so far higher education or professional courses we need funds to support them. We would like to build up the endowment fund for the higher education for un-sponsored children at Pannai. We welcome liberal donations towards this fund.

White washing and Color washing: We need nearly Rs 1,25,000.00 towards the color and white washing at our Pannai for all the buildings, which we are doing once in four years. "We expect great things from God to attempt great things for God!"
