

### Christmas Celebration...

On December 8. Christmas was celebrated with dances, carols and Christmas play. The occasion was joyous with a wonderful message from the chief guest Bro. Ravi Kumar, College of Nursing, CMC Hospital that made everyone ponder over the birth of our Lord.

Two Wheelers... We were very fortunate to have two 'Yamaha Crux' model motorbikes at 50% discount for the Home and school from Yamaha Motors, Delhi through the kindness of Mr. Sandeep Dhingara, Managing Director of Fact Entry, UK and Fact Entry, India and also the Managing Partner of SETCO YAMAHA - Delhi.

Visitors... The American group headed by Rev. Frank Everett spent four days at the school. During this time they taught new songs, observed a few classes, led the morning assembly twice and did health screening for the Home children as well as outside students. The team consisting of Doctors and Nurses carried out health screening such as General, Eye and Dental check up. Also they donated a few story books and toiletries. Rev. Jaquelyn Foster's church came forward to sponsor three of our day students, who have lost atleast one of their parents, We were greatly blessed by the visit of two Conference Ministers Rev. Douglas Anders and Rev. Dr. Sheldon Culver, Illinois South Conference UCC from the United States. They represented St. Peter's church of Coupland, Texas which sponsors four of our home children and one day student.

Mrs. Ann Witchalls a missionary from UK and friend of one of our sponsors John and Marion Walden visited us on the 28th of December.

- The buildings comprising nursery, cottages and staff quarters at MBKG Pannai are 44 years old and wearing down. Each building needs to be protected by a rooftop structure to prevent water seeping into the structures and prevent the building from further damage. A steel structure on top of each building would cost around ₹.200,000 - USD 4000.
- The buildings have to be white/colour washed which would cost ₹ 600,000 USD 12,000.
- Dining Hall and Betty Keen Multipurpose Hall need to be furnished with 250 Plastic chairs that would cost ₹.150,000 - USD 3000 (Each Chair costs ₹.600 USD 12).
- The Lunch Hall at the King's Senior School needs to be covered on the sides with iron grill to prevent dogs and monkeys which would costs ₹.300,000 - USD 6000.
