

King's School News

The academic year 2020 -2021 was supposed to have started in the month of June 2020. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic the schools were closed in India and regular classes were not taking place. But King's school like the rest of the schools in the district started online classes from June 15, 2020 onwards for upper classes and from July 1st for the lower classes. As most of the students are from the MBKG Pannai Home and also from surrounding rural areas, they were not in a position to buy smartphones or laptops for the online classes. While, just 25% of the students attend online classes, 50% of the students who were unable to attend online classes were given study materials from school to study at home. The remaining 25% of the students neither attended the online classes nor received the study materials from school. The school is taking necessary measures to track down these 25% of the children that are missing classes.

The number of COVID-19 cases has significantly decreased since November 2020 and with growing concerns surrounding the future course of action for students of Classes 10 and 12, who will have to take their board examinations, the State government decided to reopen schools for students from grade 9 to 12 alone on January 19, 2021. As per the Government instructions classes are being conducted with all precautions and standard operating Procedures for the safety of the students as well as the teachers are being followed strictly for the prevention of Covid-19. Parents are happy to send their children to school. However, it is a very challenging period for the teachers to bring back the study pattern for students because of the long break. Schools have been receiving Multivitamins and Zinc Sulphate tablets from the Government Primary Health Centres and are advised to administer these supplements to the students periodically to boost their immune system.

In the meantime, the national festivals like Independence Day (August 15) and Republic day (January 26) were celebrated modestly. Recently, Tamil Nadu State Government has announced that all students from kindergarten to grade 11 should be promoted without conducting the final exams. However, Grade 12 students will appear for board exams from the first week of May 2021.

Routine Vaccination for the Children





In November 2020, Public Health Nurses from Government Primary Health Centre, Thiruvalam administered booster dose of Diphtheria Tetanus (DT) Vaccine for the children between the age group of 5 to 15. The PHC also gives us a monthly supply of Sanitary Napkins for the girls and Deworming tablets as well as over the counter medicines such as Paracetamol and Vitamin Supplements.

Visit of Government Officers

The District Social Welfare Officer (DSWO), the District Child Protection Officer (DCPO) and the District Child Welfare Committee (CWC) members visit the Home periodically to inspect the facility, interact with the residents, check the Records and Registers and also to inspect the overall maintenance of the Home. Besides, these regular officers' visit in the end of last year, a few other officers from the district administration visited the Home.

Mr. J. Partheeban, the District Revenue Officer, visited the Home with his family and sponsored a special meal for the children and elders. He also donated stationary items for the children. He appreciated the facilities available to the children and elders and also the care given to them.
